Post-Spring Break Learning Schedule

As a result of the instructional hours waiver provided by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and stated in Governor Tony Evers' mandate release on Tuesday, March 17, the OASD has more flexibility to direct Teaching and Learning than what we recommended at the onset of this pandemic planning.

Beginning with the Monday after Spring Break, Mondays will be used as collaboration and team planning days for teachers and staff. Virtual Learning Days will occur on Tuesday-Friday during the week. Based on feedback, as well as so many successes this week, it is clear that the time for teachers to collaborate is increasingly necessary in the virtual environment. Our intent is not to have less instruction, but high-quality instruction throughout the week.
