### IMPORTANT SCHEDULE INFORMATION

#### *Spring Holiday & April Schedule Changes*

Please be aware of the following reminders and modifications to our District calendar as we continue our Virtual Learning into the month of April:

#### *City of Oconomowoc Election Day Poll Changes*

The City of Oconomowoc will use the former K-Mart facility, located at 1450 Summit Avenue, as the polling place for all wards and districts for the April 7, 2020, election. This change affects aldermanic districts 1-4 and wards 1-16.

#### *Food Service Updates for All OASD Families*

All OASD families in need, who have at least one student enrolled in an OASD school, will now be able to pick up a full week of breakfast and lunch “Grab and Go” meals at Oconomowoc High School East Campus. Families do not need to be using the free and reduced lunch program to pick up these meals.

#### **The next pick up dates and times are as follow:**

- Sunday, April 5: 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.
- Monday, April 6: 8:00-10:00 a.m. or 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.

This program will continue as long as the OASD is closed and it will allow families an easy food pick-up plan. District social workers will be on hand to help families through this process. If you do not have a vehicle, please contact your school social worker for delivery arrangements. The OASD recognizes that many families are experiencing hardship due to loss of work; if in need of meals please stop by. We will find a way to support your needs with community donations that have been coming in.
