OASD Field Trip, Course, and Various Fee Reimbursement

OASD schools and the District Business Office have received a number of inquiries about field trips, courses, and various other fees paid or charged to accounts. The District is monitoring the fluidity of the COVID19 pandemic and will refund certain fees paid or will delete charges from student accounts. Once a fee has been identified as refundable (i.e. the field trip or event is permanently cancelled), a credit will be issued on your Skyward account.

- If you paid the fee online through Family Access, your reimbursement will be made electronically to the original credit card or bank debit account charged.
- If the purchase was made via the Webstore, refunds will be made directly to the credit card or bank debit account charged.
- If you paid the fee by cash or check, you will receive a refund check.

The District is anticipating a significant volume of refunds/fee changes and are working to create an efficient, timely process. Fee statements will continue to be generated and emailed each month. Refunds and removal of fees from student accounts will be done as soon as possible, with a plan to process all reimbursements by June 15, 2020.
