### NEW UPDATES

#### *Summer School 2020 Update*

Registration for Summer School 2020 closed April 22, and families probably have questions about whether Summer School can proceed or not. The District has been working on several Summer School scenarios that include Summer School moving forward as planned or Summer School transitioning to virtual learning. These plans are dependent on the direction of Governor Evers and the Safer At Home order. In early May, OASD will share information on the various options being developed with families who are registered for Summer School and if needed, assist with rearranging class schedules or issuing refunds. The OASD School Board will review OASD's Summer School scenario plans at the May 19 regular board meeting and their input, along with direction from the State will help finalize the 2020 Summer School plan.
