OASD Fall 2020 Planning

Earlier this week, Dr. Rindo sent a message to all OASD families with information on the planning timeline the district will be using to develop our school return plans for Fall 2020. It also included details on all of the ways that your feedback has and will continue to be important throughout this process.

We don't know what lies ahead with the COVID-19 pandemic but the district, together with the School Board, will make final decisions based on the most current guidance available. The District will craft health and safety requirements based on what will best serve our students, staff, and community.

The Tragic Death of George Floyd

We all have watched as events have unfolded in the Twin Cities, and in cities across the country and throughout our state, that have demonstrated the anger and frustration that exists as a result of George Floyd's death in Minneapolis this past week.

This tragedy serves as a reminder of the important diversity work that continued during the 2019-20 school year in the OASD but was interrupted by school closures related to the COVID-19 crisis. We want the OASD school community to know that while that work was interrupted, it has not been forgotten.

A letter was sent yesterday to all OASD families from Dr. Rindo and OASD School Board President Dr. Rick Grothaus addressing this tragedy and the continued work in the OASD. This includes our work focusing on diversity, our pursuit of equity of educational outcomes and infusion of culturally sustaining practices in our schools.
