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August Summer School Program Update

The OASD School Board, Administration, and OASD faculty have been working to determine the safety measures needed for our August Summer School programs, many of which are performing arts courses. At this time, we have determined that the OHS college readiness courses and Freshman Experience can be offered in a virtual format. All other summer performing arts programs at the Intermediate and High School level will be canceled so that the performing arts department and administration can use August to prepare for the start of music education in the fall.

Online Registration for the 2020-21 School Year Open Until August 6

Next week, the OASD will email the formal Online Registration information to families. Online registration will be open from July 20-August 6, 2020, and **all OASD families are required to complete this process** for each child. The District will ask families for their final learning scenario selections, per child, during this registration process.

Food Service Schedule for June – August

The OASD will continue to provide "Grab and Go" style breakfast and lunch for students through August 24, 2020. Any family in need can pick up a full week of breakfast and lunch "Grab and Go" meals for their children, age 18 and younger, at Oconomowoc High School East Campus, located at 915 E. Summit Avenue, Oconomowoc, on Mondays between 8:00 -10:00 a.m. and 4:00 - 6:00 p.m.

Families do not need to be using the free and reduced lunch program, and do not need to attend an OASD school to utilize this meal program.

- Monday, August 17: 8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. or 4:00-6:00 p.m.
- Monday, August 24: 8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. or 4:00-6:00 p.m.
