



# How To Be a Successful Student in OVLC

## GENERAL TIPS

- Core courses are taught by a teacher guiding the learning process, reviewing student work, and regularly meeting with students in live sessions to teach content/skills, facilitate discussions, conduct activities, etc.
- Core courses are taught using both Canvas and Edgenuity.
- Elective courses are supported by a teacher who will ensure the student is on pace, maintaining their grades, scheduling their time appropriately, etc. An elective teacher will occasionally review assignments, ensure a student is ready for larger assessments, facilitate a reflection of low-scoring assignments, and unlock activities in Edgenuity.
- Elective courses are taught exclusively through Edgenuity.
- Students should be taking notes during live instruction as well as while reading/watching videos/etc.
- Students may be asked to share their computer screens with their teacher while working through individual problems or tasks.

## CANVAS

- The “modules” is where you will find all the assignments, and the lessons and other information necessary for understanding the assignments.
- All assignments assigned in Canvas should be submitted in Canvas - no email or shared submissions.
- The schedule for the week will be posted on your course’s Homepage in Canvas.
- Students can gain access to Canvas through their bookmarks or ClassLink.

## EDGENUITY

- Core courses post their lessons for the entire week - check Canvas to see what is due each day.
- You get two attempts at an assignment/quiz - you must get above 60% to advance to the next activity.
  - If you need more than two attempts, contact your teacher to work through a review/reflection and subsequent reassessment.
  - Don’t rush through an assignment! Take your time, as you would in the classroom. It will take you longer if you have to reassess with a teacher because you rushed.
- Students can gain access to Edgenuity through Canvas or ClassLink.
