
2020-21 Online Registration Open July 20 – August 6, 2020

Online registration for the 2020-21 school year is open now through August 6, 2020, and occurs within your [online Family Access account](#). You must complete the registration process **for each student** by August 6 to ensure accurate student records on the first day of school. Upon completion of online registration, you will receive an email confirming that you have completed the process. If you do not receive an email, please log in to your online Family Access account to verify that the process is complete for each student.

Families that do not complete the online registration process by August 6, 2020, will be required to enroll in the face-to-face learning option. The Ocon Virtual Learning Community and hybrid learning model will not be available for registration after August 6.

OASD FALL 2020 RETURN TO SCHOOL

At their June 30 meeting, the OASD School Board approved three learning models that families can select for their children to return to school. Those models are:

- Face-to-face learning in the traditional school environments for grades 4K-12 with mitigation measures in place for the safety of students and staff.
- Ocon Virtual Learning Community, a fully online virtual learning option that families can select for grades K-12 instead of returning to the school environment.
- A physically distanced learning format for grades K-6 that provides more social distancing but requires additional parent support for students, and will be offered if there is enough interest per grade.

During the registration process, you will be required to select the learning scenario you would like for your child in the 2020-21 school year. NEW: HEALTH CONDITIONS & IMMUNIZATION VERIFICATION PROCESS

This year the health conditions and immunization verification process can be done online. There are several new steps during online registration, where you will be asked to check and update your child's health conditions and immunization record. Step-by-step instructions are attached to this email if you need help.

NEW: COVID-19 ATTESTATION

There is a new step within Online Registration where families will be asked to read several COVID-19 documents, including the new illness guidelines, exposure exclusion expectations, student travel information, and infection control mitigation and isolation protocol. Families will be required to confirm they have read and understood this information before completing Online Registration.

NEW: MEDICATION & CARE PLAN DROP OFF FOR ELEMENTARY & INTERMEDIATE STUDENTS

- Medications and care plans for Elementary and Intermediate students can be dropped off by appointment at Oconomowoc High School throughout the summer.

NEW: STUDENT CHROMEBOOK & DEVICE PROGRAM INFORMATION

- In the 2020-21 school year, the student Chromebook Program will expand so that students in grades 2-12 will have access to a Chromebook, and students in grades K-1 will have access to an iPad.
- During Online Registration, families with students in grades 4-12 will be asked to complete a Chromebook Agreement. Families can also purchase optional Chromebook insurance during Online Registration.
- Information on iPad use and expectations for grades K-1, and Chromebook use and expectations for grades 2-3 will be shared later in summer.

NEW: STUDENT FEES PAYMENT

There are many uncertainties with the school schedule in fall, and changes to school activities that result in fee refunds may occur. Families are still required to pay the 2020-21 student fees during online registration, but establishing a payment plan is a way for families to reduce the costs that need to be paid at the start of the year. The Payment Plan Agreement form is attached, and any OASD family can choose this option.

NEW: OHS MATERIALS PICK UP & PICTURE DAY – AUGUST 6, 2020

- OHS students can pick up parking permits, have student ID photos taken, and drop off medications and health care plans on Thursday, August 6, from 9:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. inside the OHS Field House.

- Students will be asked to socially distance while they wait in line.
- Medication drop-off WILL ONLY be available for OHS students during Materials Pick Up. Please see the information above for Elementary and Intermediate medication drop off throughout the summer.

NEW: REGISTRATION ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE

- Computer access, registration assistance, and translation services will be available at Oconomowoc High School East Campus, 915 E. Summit Avenue, from 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday. To ensure the health of visitors and staff, we ask families to stay at a social distance while waiting for computer access or assistance. If several families arrive for assistance at the same time, we may ask people to wait or return at a different time.
- In-person registration assistance and translation assistance will also be available from 9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 6, 2020, at the Oconomowoc High School Field House.
