### UPDATES

#### *Wisconsin Department of Health Services Quarantine Guidelines Update*

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) acted on Friday, December 4, to adopt the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations to reduce the length of quarantines for close contacts within certain parameters. These new DHS guidelines went into effect on Monday, December 7. The OASD also began following these guidelines on Monday, December 7 and quickly contacted all families with a student in quarantine if they were able to return to school earlier than originally planned.

#### *OHS Winter Sports Attendance*

The Classic Eight Conference Superintendents and Athletic Directors have decided that in order to help control the spread of COVID-19, there need to be restrictions on attendance during high school winter sports. Because of this, only the "home" school student-athletes will receive two adult tickets to attend their home winter events. These guidelines will be re-evaluated in early January once all conference schools return from winter break.

2. Complete a separate order form for each student.
3. **Submit your student's order before 2:00 p.m. on Fridays so their meals are available the following week.**
4. Pick up meals on Mondays, between 4:00-6:00 p.m. for the entire week.
5. If a holiday or non-school day is on a Monday, meal pick up will occur on Tuesday, between 4:00-6:00 p.m.
6. If a school week is shortened because of a holiday or non-school day, the number of meals will be adjusted accordingly.
