Face Mask Requirements

The State Assembly voted last week to eliminate the face mask mandate in Wisconsin. The Governor then issued a new emergency order regarding face masks. This new emergency order is expected to expire on March 20, 2021. Please remember that the OASD has a District face mask requirement for staff, students, and District visitors anytime the State mandate is eliminated.

Request to Move Between OVLC & In-Person Learning for Third Trimester

Students in grades 4K-8 have one last opportunity to move between the Ocon Virtual Learning Community (OVLC) and in-person learning this school year. Please follow these steps if you would like to move your child into or out of the OVLC:

- Deadline to request a transfer into or out of the OVLC: 4:00 p.m. on February 17, 2021.
- Only Intermediate & Elementary students are eligible.
- Families must [complete this online form](#) to request a move between OVLC and in-person learning at an intermediate or elementary school.
- OVLC or school staff will email families of students moving between the OVLC and in-person learning during the week of February 22, to provide information about that transition.
- The first day of Third Trimester: March 1, 2021.

School Meals for Virtual Students

Breakfast and lunch are available for all OASD students on their virtual learning days during the 2020-21 school year. Students can order meals each week and pick up those meals every Monday at Oconomowoc High School. Student breakfast and lunch will continue to be free because of the USDA sponsored free meal program.

Families are required to complete a few simple steps on a weekly basis to receive these meals:

1. [Click this link to reach the online order form.](#)
2. Complete a separate order form for each student.
3. **Submit your student's order before 2:00 p.m. on Fridays so their meals are available the following week.**
4. Pick up meals on Mondays, between 4:00-6:00 p.m. for the entire week.
5. If a holiday or non-school day is on a Monday, meal pick up will occur on Tuesday, between 4:00-6:00 p.m.
6. If a school week is shortened because of a holiday or non-school day, the number of meals will be adjusted accordingly.
