High School	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Allow immediate classroom access in the morning to reduce hallway traffic.✓ Provide additional entry points for morning arrival to reduce pinch points at entry.✓ Provide assigned locations for students to eat lunch to reduce crowding.
