Hey, Gold Day Raccoons!

We will resume face-to-face instruction under our Purple/Gold Hybrid Model beginning on Monday, November 30. We plan to stay in this instructional model until Friday, December 18, and will be off school from December 19-January 3, for winter break.

We are prepared for this, Raccoons! While there are varying opinions and thoughts about all of our instructional models, we need to rally together and move forward. We have learned so much and progressed not only as learners but as teachers since we started in the Purple/Gold Hybrid Model this past September.

The purpose of this communication is to outline the instructional format, discuss the modifications we have made since the September rollout of the Purple/Gold Hybrid Model, and provide you with the resources needed to be successful.

Important Changes to our Purple/Gold Hybrid Model:

To increase accountability, there are some slight modifications to our Purple/Gold Hybrid Model. These modifications include:

- Freshmen and Sophomores are required to stay at school until 2:40 p.m. on their face-to-face days.
- Juniors are required to stay at school until 1:45 p.m. on their face-to-face days.
- Seniors will still be allowed to leave school at lunch on their face-to-face days.

OHS Student Group Designations Assigned by Last Names

Student cohort designations remain as they were in fall. In general, students are assigned by their last name.

Last name starting A-K	Purple Group
Last name starting L-Z	Gold Group



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GOLD Academic Calendar Overview

- Students will report to OHS for in-person classes on their designated GOLD days and work remotely on their designated PURPLE days (the same structure we followed in September).
- Students will learn remotely in scheduled classes on designated GREY days (same schedule we followed from November 3-November 24).
- The PURPLE days have two letters next to the date. These are the classes, or the associated skinnies, that you will meet with during your afternoon academic time on remote days.
