



## WELCOME TO GREENLAND ELEMENTARY



Greenland is the quintessential neighborhood school. Located in the heart of Oconomowoc, Greenland Elementary is within walking distance to Fowler Lake and Lac La Belle.

### CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT

Our school is continuously working to improve our student's growth in literacy and math. Weekly collaboration meetings are one action step of our Building Leadership Team, crafted to increase student achievement in reading. During the 2017-2018 school year, the Oconomowoc Area School District (OASD) implemented a new math curriculum, Bridges in Mathematics. Throughout the implementation, teachers had many opportunities to collaborate with colleagues in our school and around the district. Greenland, along with the other OASD Elementary Schools, has implemented a program called PIE (Practice, Intervention, and Extension) time. PIE time is an opportunity for extra Practice, Enrichment, or Intervention outside of standard instruction, providing students with additional personalized learning opportunities. As a result of our efforts, students have shown strong growth as measured by district and standardized assessments.

### RECOGNITION

In 2017-18, Greenland Elementary received several recognitions from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and the Wisconsin RtI Center. Greenland was among 40 schools from across the state to be recognized by the Wisconsin DPI as a High Progress School. The Wisconsin RtI Center awarded Greenland with a Silver Level Award in behavior and Bronze Level Award in reading, for our implementation of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports. The staff at Greenland have been hugely successful in implementing systems to support students both academically and behaviorally.

### ACCOMPLISHMENTS DURING THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

We offer a number of extra-curricular clubs and activities throughout the school year. In addition to these extra-curricular activities, our students accomplished some amazing things this year:

- Greenland Elementary students raised \$11,000 for Jump Rope For Heart
- WTMJ4 recognized the second-grade team for their 15 years of contributing to the Community Baby Shower. Students and families donated baby items for families in need.
- Greenland 5K-4th grade students participated in the "Hour of Code," where students worked as real programmers

### FACILITIES UPDATE

During the summer of 2017, Greenland Elementary completed several facility improvement projects. Heating, ventilation, and mechanical systems were replaced, and cooling systems were added. On September 15, 2017, Greenland Elementary, the OASD, and community celebrated the construction completion.

### GREENLAND PTO

The Greenland school community is extremely fortunate to have a dedicated PTO. During the 2017-2018 school year, the PTO assisted in purchasing two additional playground pieces. Our students were very excited to use the new teeter-totter and rock climber. The PTO was also vital in supplementing funds for an artist in residence, as well as, the Best Buddies Program. The PTO sponsors numerous family events, including Family Movie Night, Scholastic Book Fair, Science Fair, Read-A-Thon, a Carnival, and the Greenland Games.

### PARENT SATISFACTION SURVEY RESULTS

During the fall of 2017, a parent satisfaction survey was distributed across the district. 72 parents/caregivers participated in the survey. Thank you to the many families who took the time to share feedback with us. Parents shared:

### SCHOOL PERFORMANCE: MAP TEST

OASD students take a computerized assessment called Measures of Academic Progress™ (MAP). MAP tests measure academic achievement and growth throughout the school year, and from year to year. Students are assessed in reading, language use, and mathematics. The total test time ranges from 1 to 3 hours. MAP tests are unique in that they adapt to a child’s level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed and maintain a positive attitude toward testing. Most importantly, the test identifies instructional growth opportunities for each child.

MAP results are also used to compare OASD school performance against national achievement and growth norms. A school’s national percentile rank score (1-99) indicates its relative standing among US schools participating in MAP testing. A score of 50 represents the national average. Schools earning percentile rank scores > 80 are considered “unrivaled” by statistical standards.

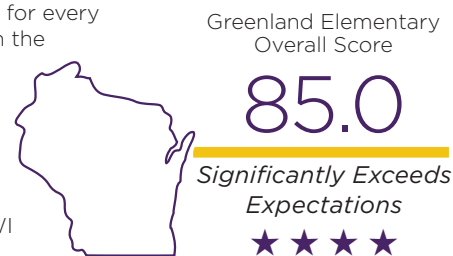
